Constitution

(provides a separation of powers)



Legislative (makes laws)



Congress



Senate

100 elected senators total;
2 senators per state



House of Representatives

435 elected representatives
total; representatives based
on each state's population



Executive (carries out laws)



President



Vice President



Cabinet

Nominated by the
president and must be
approved by the Senate
(with at least 51 votes)



Judicial (evaluates laws)



Supreme Court

9 justices nominated by
the president and must be
approved by the Senate
(with at least 51 votes)
